### Stress timed - languages usually with

- strong vowel reduction
- lexical stress
- complex syllable structure
- a bigger ratio of consonants in relation to vowels
- The intervals between stressed syllables are about even

### Syllable timed - languages usually

- lacking vowel reduction,
- fixed stress or not,
- simpler syllable structure,
- more percentage of vowel time.
- The time between syllables is about the same.





Focus on stress & rhythm Teach sentences or lexical chunks Let your students find the beat Use different senses Exposure is key!





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


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
