A quick history lesson



Eric Mazur (1991)

- Dutch, Physics Lecturer from Harvard University
- Peer Instruction (PI) .
- Seating arrangement plays an important role
- Low-performing students are seated in the front, their chance to do better increases.
- High-performing students are seated in the outer four corners of the classroom, the performance of the class as a whole increases
- Collaborative learning out of classroom



Salmon Khan (2006)

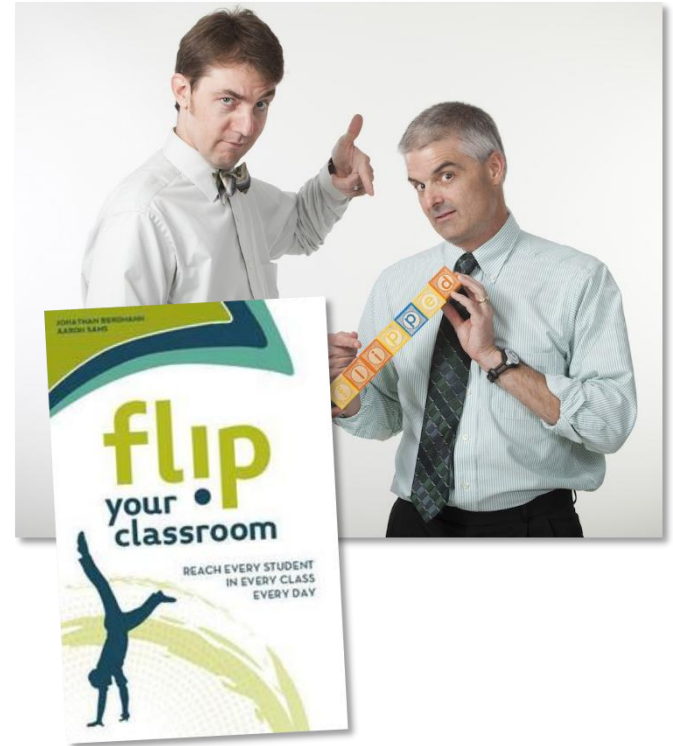
- Ex Hedge Fund Analyst
- Began making videos to 'save time' helping to tutor cousins in 2006
- Allowing students to **watch the videos** in their **own time** and repetively
- **Focused on the problems** they raised
- Noticed their results improving
- Expanded globally to 1.6 billion views (2018)
- Mission to help children everywhere
- Access to technology



Khan Academy

Bergmann & Sams (2007)

- Began 2007
- Woodland Park High School chemistry
- Some students missed classes
- Recorded lectures and posted them online
- Those scores increased in their classes
- Lectures online - experiments in class
- Started a global movement
- Reach every student every class

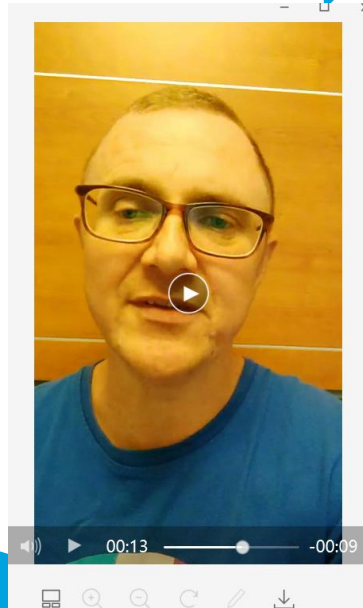

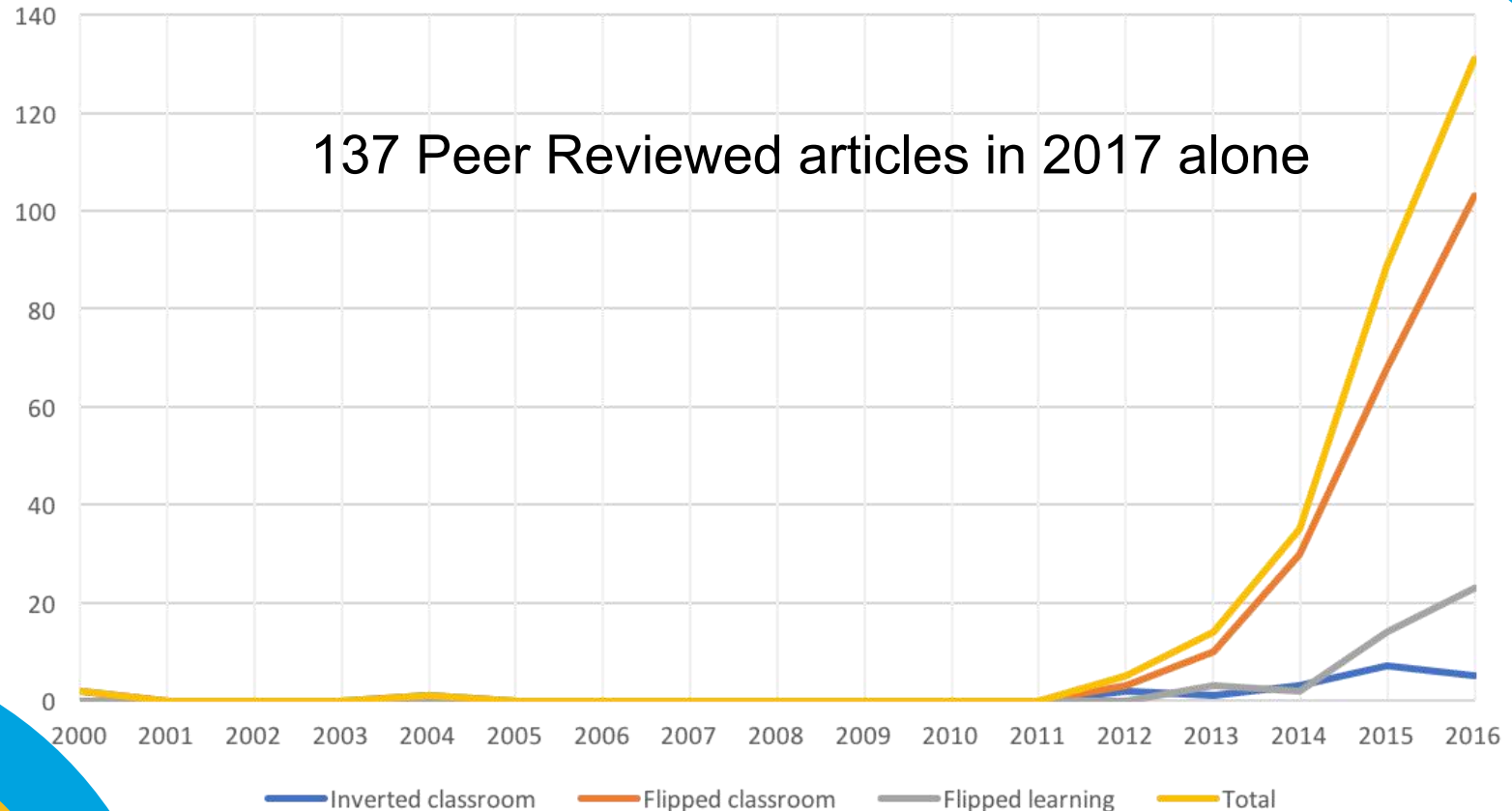
So...is it just a fad?

1. Student and Parent Prep

- How at-home and in-class time will be spent.
- How long your at-home lessons will be.
- How you'll be evaluating their progress.
- What positive results you expect from flipping your classroom.

2. A Platform for At-home Lessons

- A way to make short videos
- A method to share content (Wechat, Line, FB)
- Printable worksheets - highly visual

3. In-class Practice Materials
